What is more likely than that while the Government at Washington temporizes, some commander or captain, spoiling for a row, will pounce upon a Canadian scaler? What then? I close my mind's eye to shut out the terrible picture which unfolds nefore it.

Who can predict the results of such a cruel wor? May the God of Nations, who alone can command peace, sive us from such a war.

The claims of the United States Government to jurisduction of the seas on any sea beyond the limit pre-cribed by the laws of maners is too prepes terous and absurd to be worthy of notice.

If I am not greatly mi-taken, Uncle Sam will have enough to do to preserve internal peace and autonomy, without hezaroing war to protect the

seals, or rather a sealing company.

There are, I believe, disintergrating influences at work in the neighboring Republic which will result in quartering its 4 reitory. But more of this anon. Peace be with you,




