#### ARTICLE XIX

### Administrative Arrangements

The appropriate military authorities of the Sudan and Canada may establish mutually satisfactory procedures not inconsistent with the provisions contained herein, to carry out the intent of this Agreement and to give effect to its provisions.

#### ARTICLE XX

#### Revision

Either Canada or the Sudan may at any time request revision of any of the provisions of this Agreement.

#### ARTICLE XXI

## Entry into Force and Termination

This Agreement shall enter into force upon signature and shall have effect retroactively from April 1, 1978. It shall remain in force until terminated by one of the following methods:

- (a) by either Government after six months' written notice to that effect has been given to the other Government;
- (b) without complying with subparagraph (a) of this Article, by the withdrawal from Canada of all trainees by the Sudan where such withdrawal is in the public interest of the Sudan; or
- (c) without complying with subparagraph (a) of this Article, by Canada without previous notification if Canada decides that such termination is in the public interest of canada.

IN WITNESS WHEREOF, the undersigned, being duly authorized by their respective Governments, have signed this Agreement.
