- Major ongoing projects include the Canada-China Enterprise Management Training Centre, assistance to open cities, the China Council for International Co-operation on Environment and Development, lean swine production, the South China power studies project, the Oil and Gas Technology Transfer Program, and comprehensive transport management training.
- CIDA has recently put in place a new country development policy framework for China which will serve as a guide for all future programming. From now on, all CIDA programs in China will focus on economic co-operation, environmental sustainability, human rights and democratic development, and good governance. In addition, CIDA's concerns about women in development and reduction of poverty will continue to be emphasized.
- Since the new country development policy framework was launched in July 1994, by Foreign Affairs Minister André Ouellet, letters of intent have been signed for nine new initiatives in the areas of environmental sustainability, economic co-operation, good governance and women in development.
