SIR,

I have the honour to refer to the discussions which have taken place between the authorities of the United States and Canadian Governments concerning the extension of the Agreement between Canada and the United States of America Regarding the Leasing of Certain Lands Situated Within R.C.A.F. Station Goose Bay, Newfoundland, effected by the Exchange of Notes of December 5, 1952 (1).

As a result of the above discussions, Aides Mémoire dated May 8 and May 31, 1972, were exchanged whereby the two governments arrived at an understanding concerning the extension of the term of the lease agreement in respect of the United States Air Force Base at Goose Bay until June 30, 1973.

Therefore, I have the honour to propose that this Note and your reply to that effect shall constitute the agreement between our two Governments to extend, under the same terms and conditions, the term of the Agreement Regarding the Leasing of Certain Lands Situated Within R.C.A.F. Station Goose Bay of December 5, 1952, until June 30, 1973; such agreement to take effect on the date of your reply.
