His Excellency Dr. Jaroslav Tauer to-day presented his Letter of Credence as Ambassador Extraordinary and Plenipotentiary of Czechoslovakia to Canada.

The ceremony took place at Government House at 11:00 a.m. The Chief of Protocol, Mr. Henry F. Davis, presented the Ambassador to His Excellency the Governor-General.

Mr. M.H. Wershof, Assistant Under-Secretary of State for External Affairs and Mr. Esmond Butler, Secretary to the Governor-General, were in attendance on the Governor-General on this occasion.

Dr. Tauer has been Minister to Canada since April 8, 1960. His appointment as Ambassador follows the elevation of the Legation to the status of Embassy.
