### APPOINTMENTS TO CANADIAN COMMERCIAL CORPORATION

Ottawa - International Trade Minister John C. Crosbie announced the appointment of two new Directors of the Canadian Commercial Corporation, Harold L. Wareham of Newfoundland and Andrew Saxton of British Columbia.

Harold L. Wareham is Chairman and Chief Executive Officer of Air Nova Inc., and President and Chief Executive Officer of Atlantis Corporation Limited, both of St. John's, Newfoundland. A Chartered Accountant, Mr. Wareham was previously Executive Vice-President of Eastern Provincial Airways Ltd., and Comptroller of the Newfoundland Division of John Labatt Ltd. Mr. Wareham holds directorships in the Atlantis Group of Companies and is a member of the Board of Regents and Chairman of the Finance Committee of Memorial University of Newfoundland.

Andrew Saxton is active in a number of business and charitable organizations in Vancouver, British Columbia. Previously Executive Vice-President of Laurentide Financial Corporation Ltd., and Chairman of Grouse Mountain Resorts Ltd., Mr. Saxton is currently a Director of British Columbia Television Broadcasting System Ltd., Northwest Sports Enterprises Ltd. (Vancouver Canucks NHL), and Western Canadian Land Corporation. A member of the Executive Board, International Society and Federation of Cardiology, based in Geneva, Switzerland, and an Honorary Member of the Royal Canadian Legion, Mr. Saxton is a past President of the B.C. Heart Foundation, and has served as First Vice-President of the Vancouver Opera Association.

The Canadian Commercial Corporation is a federal Crown corporation which acts as prime contractor in government-to-government export sales to support Canadian exporters. It reports to Parliament through the Minister for International Trade.
