- 1. The Teams are comprised of three speakers a side.
- The leaders are allowed 20 minutes for their opening speeches and fifteen minutes for reply. The supporters are allowed fifteen minutes each for their speeches.
- 3. The debate is opened by the affirmative leader followed by the negative leader and the affirmative and negative speakers alternately. After the last negative speaker has finished the negative leader replies and the debate is closed by the reply of the affirmative leader.
- 4. All decisions as to relevancy of subject matter or other protests are subject to the decision of the Adjudicator.

OREGON PLAN.

- 1. The teams are comprised of two men a side.
- 2. The leaders are allowed thirty minutes. The supporters are allowed ten minutes each for cross-examination and twenty minutes each for summing up.
- 3. The debate is opened by the presentation of the full affirmative case by the affirmative leader who is then cross-examined by the negative supporter. The negative leader then sets out the negative case and is cross-examined by the af firmative supporter. The negative supporter than sums up and the debate is closed by the summing up of the affirmative supporter.
- 4. All questions as to relevancy of questions, subject matter or other protests are subject to the decision of the adjudicator.
