- 14.—The Council shall be regulated in their proceedings by such By-laws as may from time to time be enacted by them;—no By-Law being in any case altered, or new one proposed, without at least one month's notice of such intention being given to each member of Council.
- 15.—The Annual Prize Meeting shall be held alternately in the several Provinces of the Dominion, at such times and places as may be determined on by the Council.
- 16.—The Prizes shall be competed for in accordance with such Regulations as may be passed by the Council from time to time.
- 17.—An Annual Report, embracing the audited account of the Finances, shall be drawn up by the Secretary, and shall, (having been previously submitted to the Council) be published as soon after the Prize Meeting as may be found practicable.
- 18.—There shall be an Annual meeting to be held at such time as shall be selected by the Council.
