William Cochrane, D.D., the retiring Moderator, conducted Divine service, and preached a sermon from the Book of Joshua, the thirteenth chapter, the first verse, the last clause of the verse—" *There remaineth yet very much land to be possessed.*"

Dr. Cochrane then constituted the Assembly with prayer.
