County Council, and Lord Derby was Mayor of Liverpool. You will find throughout Scotland also that soms of ths hest men are serving their municipalities. make comparisons, not quite satisfactory to myself, hotween our municipal officers and the municipal officers of the Old Land. I know many of them in the Old Country, and they ars men of the greatest wealth and position.

## NATIONAL DEFENCE.

"The defence of the nation is the higher field. It is first the cultivation of a national spirit. That is the foundation question, for without a national spirit people would not move for the defence of the nation. Without a national spirit meney could not be taxatlon for the nation; and without a national obtained nohody would cars whether the nation prospered or whether it falied. It is very much to he regretted that the national spirit in Canada is not reaching that high Ideal of activity and enthusiasm which many of us would like, and yet it is pleasant to think that the national has grown very much in the last 25 or 30 years. was a time when we could scarcely say that ws national soul of our own. We were like lnfants crying for the light. Our system of transportation inadequate, and nohody seemed to care whether prospered or not. There came an awakening, however. cams with Confederation. Then we began to feel that ws had a future. We hegan to reach out eastward and westward until we embraced the whole country from the Atlantle to the Pacific. As years roiled on we began to realize our possibilities; we began to think it was possible for Canada to he a nation. I hope there are no doubters in regard to that now.

"The national spirit is what makes us a strong nation. I am glad that the Defence League has at heart the cultivation of a national spirit, holding before our young men ideals of purity and manliness, of public service and Industry, without which the better elements of society not prevail, and without which they could not effectively govern. There are two or three elements essential national spirit in Canada: a reasonable mixed races and diverse creeds; we have too much to do to quarrel among ourselves. We want to be united in a for common basis. The British Emplre is the hest defender of the home in the world. Let us not, howsvsr, fear ahout Canada so long as ws pour into the general estate a wealth of physical and intellectual strength.
