tersign which is given by the sergeant of the escort, and not the parole; the parole is to be known only by the officers of the Rounds, and commanders of Guards.

6. Whenever the Commandant of the Garrison goes the Rounds in the night, he will announce himself, (Commandant's Visiting Rounds) and will give the parole and countersign.

These Orders to be returned to the Town Major, on Regiments leaving this Garrison, or paid for at the rate of 5s. each copy.

The Orders relative to the Duties of the Garrison marked thus, † are to be read and explained to the men by officers commanding companies once a week.
