Big Money in Goose Raising. H. DeCourcy, the poultry expert of Ireland, says he knows a farmer who made a profit of \$1269 last year raising geese on a twenty-acre farm. He paid geese on a twenty-acre larm. He had \$100 rent and food for 458 geese cost him \$510. He sold 418 young geese for \$1554, and 653 eggs for \$277.
