CORNWALL, Aug. 27.—(Special).—Near Dickinson Centre, N. Y., while they were engaged in blasting rock in a field, Melvin Wood, a prosperous farmer, was working with an assistant named William McClure, clearing up some land, when a charge of dynamite exploded. Both were killed.
