We, the undersigned Chief and Councillors of the Band of Indians owning the Reserve situated in Treaty No. _____ and known as "The Fisher River Reserve," do, by these presents, certify that the said Band has by vote of the majority of its voting members present at a meeting summoned for the purpose, according to the rules of the Band, and held in the presence of the Indian Agent for the locality on the Eighteenth day of November 1913 granted leave to Elijah Bowers to join our said Band, and as a member thereof to share in all land and other privileges of the Band, to which admission we, the undersigned, also give full consent.
