

on the way; we have three classes, consisting of thirty-three members; one exhorter, and three class leaders. It will be seen from other reports that there has been quite a change effected in reference to this Mission. At present the missionary lives at Thornbury,—it is the most central place. The friends on this Mission have done all they were able toward the support of our church in the year that is past. Our friends on the front may expect that soon this field will support itself.

CARLISLE MISSION.

This Mission has eight appointments, one brick chapel, and one acre of land for a burying-ground. We have one hundred and twenty members, five classes, five leaders, a full board of stewards, and one local preacher. It embraces parts of the townships of Lobo, Adelaide, and Caradoc.

DOVER MISSION.

This Mission is situated in parts of the townships of Sombra, Chatham, Dover, Camden, Wabash and Dawn, having the river Sydenham running through its centre. It has seven appointments, seven classes, a proper number of leaders, a full board of stewards, two exhorters, one local preacher, and one hundred and seventy-five members. There is one chapel, and a site procured on which to build another. On the whole, I think this is rather an encouraging field of labor. The inhabitants are generally of British origin, and their business is farming and lumbering.
