Provided, nevertheless, in every case, the Board of the Superannuation Fund shall, on recommendation of the Conference, refund the amount paid into the fund by the preacher located, together with such additional sum, if any, as may be deemed equitable by the Board.

We recommend said paragraph be altered so as to read,—"The first draft of Stations shall be placed on the table of the Conference at the close of the first Session; the second and final draft at any time before the close of the Conference, as the Conference itself may order."
