The school is as necessary to the farmer's son as it is to the son of the man engaged in any other calling.

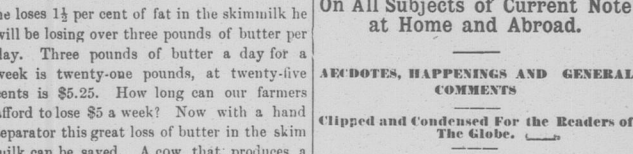
Some think it best to feed off the grass that starts in moist places; if left it becomes tough and is rejected.
