## GENERAL PRICE IMPROVEMENT

Market Determined to Go up Yesterday in Spite of Everything.

New York, June 18.—The general improvement in prices, which began before noon, continued through the afternoon and traders remarked that the market wanted to go up in spite of money, politics and commercial conditions. Crude oil sold six points above its close and some of the other Steels advanced a point or more. The Mexican Oil stocks recovered 2 to 5 points and even the motors joined the rise to a limited extent.

Some of the selling made good gains like 3 points in Reading and five in D. L. and W. usually an inactive stock. The declaration of the regular dividend on North Pacific made the short interest in the rails created by the reduction of the Chicago and North-Western dividend uneasy. The market paid no attention to the American Federation of Labor's demand for government ownership which the Street looks upon as largely a matter of fact. Cash money advanced to 9 per cent in the last hour closing at 8 per cent but did not seriously check the rise in stocks which was of course largely a covering movement.

## Norwegian Trade.

Montreal, June 17.—The arrival of the Drammund, from port from Christiania, is a reminder that the boat last year inaugurated the new direct line between Montreal and Norway under the direction of the Norwegian-American Line, for which the Canadian Pacific Ocean Services are the agents. It appears, however, that trade between the two countries has shown a falling off this year, and the cargo which will be carried by this boat will be grain and flour, which is the order of the Port Controller in Norway. The amount of general cargo offering is very little.

## New Line.

Another link between Montreal and the Far East is to be established by the Houston Lines, for which McLean Kennedy, Ltd., are local agents. The first sailing will be the Clan Campbell about July 17th, and cargo will be accepted, if sufficient inducement offers, for Port Said, Suez, Aden, Suda, Bombay, Colombo, Karachi, Madras, Rangoon, Singapore, Sumatra and Surabaya.
