The Act of the Parliament of the late Province of Lower Canada aforesaid, passed in the sixth year of the Reign of His late Majesty King William the Fourth, and intituled, *An Act to regulate the Fees of persons employed by Justices of the Peace in the Country Parishes, as Clerks or Bailiffs in certain cases*, shall be and is hereby continued to the said first day of 15

The Act of the Parliament of this Province passed in the eighteenth year of Her Majesty's reign and intituled *An Act to regulate the Militia of this Province and to repeal the Acts now in force for that purpose*, and the Act amending the same passed in the nineteenth and twentieth years of Her Majesty's Reign 35
- 19, 20 V. c. 44, continued to 1st January, 1860, &c. and intituled, *An Act to amend the Militia Law*, shall respectively be and they are hereby continued and shall remain in force until the said first day of January, one thousand eight hundred and sixty, and thence until the end of the then next ensuing session of the Provincial Parliament and no longer, 40
- subject always to the proviso contained in the last section of the Act first cited in this section and hereby continued.
- Proviso : this Act not to prevent the effect of any other Act of the present session. 5. Provided always, that nothing herein contained shall prevent the effect of any Act passed during the present Session, repealing, amending, rendering permanent, or continuing 45
- to any further period than that herein appointed, any of the Acts or Ordinances hereinbefore mentioned and continued, nor shall continue any provision or part of any of the Acts or Ordinances in this Act mentioned, which may have been re-
