# Georgii II. Regis.

An Act for granting to His Majesty certain Sums of Money out of the Sinking Fund; and applying certain Monies remaining in the Exchequer, and the Savings out of the Monies granted in this Session of Parliament for the Pay of the Troops of *Hanover*, for the Service of the Year One thousand seven hundred and fifty seven; and for further appropriating the Supplies granted in this Session of Parliament; and for Relief of *Claud Johnson*, with respect to a Bond entered into by him, for securing the Duties on Tobacco imported by *George Buchanan* and *William Hamilton*.



WE, Your Majesty's most dutiful <sup>Preamble.</sup> and loyal Subjects, the Commons of Great Britain, in Parliament assembled, being desirous to raise the Residue of the necessary Supplies which we have cheerfully granted to Your Majesty in this Session of Parliament, by Ways and Means the least burthensome to Your Majesty's Subjects, have resolved to give and grant to Your Majesty the Sums here-

in after mentioned; and do therefore most humbly beseech Your Majesty, that it may be enacted; and be it enacted by the King's most Excellent Majesty, by and with the Advice and Consent of the Lords Spiritual and Temporal, and Commons, in this present Parliament assembled, and by the Authority of the same, That by or out of such Monies as have arisen, or shall or may arise, and be and remain in the Receipt of the Exchequer, of the Surplusses, Excesses, Overplus Monies, and other Revenues compos-
