I am the only officer employed for the
Superintendence of the Indians from the
District of Gaspé, inclusively to Three-
Rivers also inclusively the distance of a
thousand miles and an interpreter at
Three Rivers both situations are to be
reduced on the first settlement —
The Salary of Superintendence £ 185. 14. 4.
per Annum. The duties of these officers are
to see to the Indians, receive them,
