And with reference to ~~the~~ letter to you of the 30<sup>th</sup> April, 1883 I have to inform you that your letter of the 30<sup>th</sup> Oct. is not an answer to the

enquiries therein made, viz. whether the 50 acres on the mainland

and the two islands <sup>which comprise the Reserve of the Teton Indians</sup> "A" and "B" are so entirely destitute of timber

as to render it necessary to purchase an additional quantity of land with timber on it for the use of the Indians.
