| Agricultural machinery | Continuance of free entry with General tariff increased from 5% to 15%. |
| Electric batteries and accumulators | Continuance of free entry with General tariff increased from 5% to 15%. |
| Motor cars, chassis, and parts of cars and trucks | Reduction from 15% ad val. to 10%, same accorded United Kingdom. (General tariff 20%). |
| Motor trucks | Continuance of free entry with General tariff increased from 5% to 10%. |
| Boots and shoes of leather, canvas or rubber | Adjustment to give preference of 20% ad val. or ls. per pair. |
| Rubber tires and tubes | Reduction from 9d. lb. to 6d. on tires and from 6d. to 3d. on tubes, same as accorded United Kingdom. (General tariff 12d. on tires and 7½d. on tubes). |
| Boxes, wooden, empty or in shooks | Continuance of free entry with General tariff increased to 20% ad val.; drawback, if any, restricted to 75%. |
| Wood, unmanufactured (lumber), including ceiling and flooring boards | Continuance of free entry with General tariff increased to 20%. |
| Newsprint paper; wrapping paper; unspecified plain or composite paper | Continuance of free entry with General tariff increased from 5% to 10%. |
| Fruit wraps | Continuance of free entry with General tariff raised from free to 5%. |
