DISPUTE BETWEEN ETHIOPIA AND ITALY.

Communication from the United Kingdom Government.

London, 15th April, 1936.

To the Secretary-General.

I am directed by Mr. Secretary Eden to transmit to you, herewith, for the information of all States members of the League of Nations, translation of a semi-official letter, as well as of the aide-memoire referred to therein, addressed to His Majesty's Ambassador in Rome by the Italian Under Secretary of State for Foreign Affairs on the 12th March last concerning the bombing by Italian aircraft of British Red Cross Ambulance unit No. I in the neighbourhood of Quoram, Ethiopia, on the 3rd, 4th, 5th and 6th March of this year.

2. I am also to enclose a copy of the note which Sir Eric Drummond handed to Signor Suvich on the 10th April replying to the two Italian communications above mentioned.
