And as I thank you for the honour which I have rereived at your hands, on behalf of Canada, may I be permitted to thank you, also, for the honour which you have bestowed upon one who, today, an exile from her own land, has honoured Canada by her royal presence. She bears with courage and dignity the sorrows of her own little land so marvellously great. She has been welcomed by the citizens of Canada to this continent, which owes so much to the character, the faith and the skill of the people to whom she has dedicated her life. The name of the Crown Princess Juliana of the Netherlands will live for all time its place in the chapter of Canadian history which will recall the moving events of this war. Canadians will be happy and proud indeed that today your generosity has made her royal name a part of American history as well.
