intervene, which motions shall have precedence in the order in which they are placed, viz.: indefinite postponement, laying on the table, reference to a committee, postponement to a given time, amendment, or a substitute.

VIII.

No member shall be interrupted when speaking, except by the President, to call him to order when he departs from the question, uses personalities or disrespectful language; but any member may call the attention of the President to the subject, when he deems a speaker out of order. And any member may explain if he thinks himself misrepresented.
