

office every week, being nearly an average of three per day. The revenue of the office for the year 1882 was \$7,114, the month of December amounting to \$912. The remittances for postage stamps sold totalled \$901. The number of registrations, consisting of registered letters, parcels and books, and including everything handled for remuneration, were 24,654. The number of registered letters mailed in Brandon for the year 1882 were 6,204, and the number of registered letters delivered at the Post Office for the same period totalled 4,961. Mr. J. C. Kavanagh is the postmaster.
