**A GREAT HOLSTEIN RECORD**  
Malcolm H. Gardiner, Delevan, Wis.  
Held in one Holstein-Friesian queen sealed on the throne, with a production so large that it seems that she surely will be able to keep her crown for some time, that she is courted by the most illustrious and reigning the throne and crown to a successor with a yet greater record. A few months ago I announced that the lady Konkke had won the crown in the seven and thirty—divisions, with the great productions of 30,422 lbs. fat from 604 lbs. milk in seven days, and 125,641 lbs. fat from 2,494 lbs. milk in 30 days. Now she must stand aside to make room for Valdesa Scott 2nd, with the much greater production of 33,116 lbs. fat from 694.6 lbs. milk in seven days and 132,809 lbs. fat from 2,533.9 lbs. milk in 30 days. These figures are so large that they cause one to wonder how any cow can produce them; yet immense as they are, I have not the slightest doubt but that in due time some other and greater Holstein cow will surpass them.

Valdesa Scott 2nd is in no way closely related in blood lines to the cows for many years prominently before the public; and the discovery of so wonderful a cow among the outsiders goes far to prove my claim that that there are hundreds of great cows in the rank and file of the Holstein-Friesian legion. "Where are these cows?" does some one ask—"Perhaps in your own herd. Do you? Do you give your cows a chance?" Every Holstein breeder, young or old, should know what he has in his own herd; but he should first make an effort to develop himself before he attempts to develop his cows. Only the broad gauge feeder who feeds understandingly, mixing his feeds with brains, will be able to make a success. Such a breeder realizes that the Holstein cow is a wonderful machine for producing feed into cash products, and organization whose wants must be studied and tastes consulted.

An Ample Test  
In offering such a wonderful record to the public, it is fitting to tell how the record was made and authenticated. All records of the Holstein-Friesian tests are conducted by supervisors appointed by State Agricultural Colleges, as are the official tests of the other dairy breeds; but in addition to this, the Holstein-Friesian Association make use of the verification test, in which a second supervisor is appointed to assist the first, so as to be able to keep the cow under constant watch day and night from the beginning to the end of the period designated by the Superintendent of Advanced Registry. The usual period is twenty-four hours; but in this case it was forty-eight hours; and in this case it was one verification period, there were three.

Prof. A. S. Cook, the officer in charge of test work for New Jersey, had appointed W. D. Goulding, one of the most experienced of N. J. supervisors, to conduct the Flanders tests; and as soon as the partial preliminary reports came in, a two-day verification test was ordered by Prof. Cook appointed Mr. E. A. Grombacher as supervisor to assist in this test; and the results corroborated the reported production of the cows at that time. This verification test was made June 21st-23rd. Later, as Valdesa Scott 2nd was steadily increasing, a second test was made, and Mr. Grombacher, a thoroughly experienced supervisor, being appointed to assist, and on June 11th-13th this great test produced 10,431 lbs. fat from 199.3 lbs. milk, an amount incredible amount. The third verification test was made on June 19th-21st. This later test was made on 30th, Mr. G. R. Rink being appointed as associate supervisor and Prof. Cook going himself to take a hand, and the result showed 8,437 lbs. fat from 287 lbs. milk. The seven and 30-day records of Valdesa Scott 2nd are the most thoroughly authenticated and tested ever made.

Collegiate Made Records  
Our State Agricultural Colleges are coming to the front with great cows. Iowa was the first to show as high as 27% lbs. fat from 733.6 lbs. milk; but now, and to be outside, we have College Belle Wayne, of South Dakota, showing 28.3 lbs. fat from 624.2 lbs. milk in days, 116,546 lbs. fat from 3,388.1 lbs. milk in 30 days. This test, with its great production of milk and fat, will prove an object lesson to South Dakota and neighboring farmers who keep cows a year to produce no more than College Belle Wayne produced in 30 days. She was largely developed through the use of the semi-official yearly test, and is to be put on long time test again next year.
