- T the Provincial Parliament, begun and holden at Quebec, the seventeenth day of December, Anno Domini one thousand seven hundred and ninety-two, in the thirty-third Year of the Reign of our Sovereign Lord GEORGE the Third, by the Grace of GOD, of Great Britain, France and Ireland, KING, Defender of the faith, &c.
- 'And from thence continued by several Prorogations to the fifth day of Janu-'ary, one thousand seven hundred and ninety-five, being the third Session of the 'first Provincial Parliament of Lower-Canada.'

CAP. I.

An Act to explain and amend an Act made in the thirty-fourth year of the reign of his present Majesty, intituled "An Act for the division of the "Province of Lower Canada, for amending the Judicature thereof, and "for repealing certain Laws therein mentioned."

HEREAS by an Act passed by the Legislative Council and by the House of Assembly in the last Session of the Legislature of this Province, intituled, "An Act for the division of the Province of Lower Canada, for amending the Judicature thereof, and for repealing certain Laws therein mentioned," which said Act was reserved by the Governor, for the signification of his Majesty's pleasure thereon, and his Majesty hath been graciously pleased to grant his assent to the same, and it was therein enacted, that the county of Gaspé should be erected
