T the Provincial Parliament, begun and holden at Quebec, the twentieth day of November, Anno Domini, One thousand eight hundred and twenty-seven, in the eighth year of the Reign of Our Sovereign Lord, GEORGE the Fourth, by the Grace of GOD, of the United Kingdom of Great Britain and Ireland, KING, Defender of the Faith, and from thence continued by several prorogations, to the twenty-second day of January, one thousand eight hundred and thirty;"

" Being the Third Session of the Thirteenth Provincial Parliament of Lower" Canada."

CAP. I.

An Act to amend an Act passed in the ninth year of His Majesty's Reign, intituled, "An Act for the more speedy remedy of divers "abuses prejudicial to Agricultural Improvement in this Province," and to make further provision to the same effect.

(26th March, 1830.)

HEREAS it is expedient to repeal a certain Act, passed in the ninth year of His Majesty's Reign, intituled, "An Act for the more speedy "remedy of divers abuses prejudicial to Agricultural Improvement in this Pro-"vince," and to provide for the prevention of certain trespasses, abuses, and evil practices which prevail in this Province, and retard the progress of Agriculture
