And be it further Ordained and Enacted by the authority aforesaid, that all Coroners, Justices of the Peace and other officers, shall return into the said Court of King's Bench for the said District of Montreal, to be holden on the twenty-seventh day of August now next ensuing, or into any Court of Oyer and Terminer in and for any District or part of the said Province, into which they shall be required to return the same, all and every their inquisitions and other proceedings had in the execution of their respective offices, which otherwise would have been returnable into the said Court of King's Bench, to be holden in the said last five days of the present month of February and the first ten days of the month of March now next ensuing.
