of the land, and to enquire into any circumstances that may appear to them material, relatively to the said Rules of Practice, and the practice of the said Courts, and that the said Committee do also report their opinion as to the course which it is expedient to pursue, for vindicating the authority of the Legislature, and repressing such abuses of Judicial Power, and that the said Committee be empowered to send for persons, records and papers.

The House divided on the question.

Yeas 18 Nays 4

So it was carried in the affirmative, and

RESOLVED accordingly.

ORDERED, That Mr. Stuart, Mr. Borgia, Mr. Papineau, Mr. Lee, Mr. Bourdages, Mr. Blanchet, and Mr. Joseph Bedard, do compose the said Committee.

Mr. Blanchet moved, seconded by Mr. Bourdages, that the Address reported to His Royal Highness the Prince Regent be, now, committed to a Committee of the whole House.

Mr. Stuart moved in amerdment, seconded by Mr. Pozer, to leave out the word "now" and substitute the words "to-morrow."

The House divided on the question of amendment.

Yeas 7 Nays 10

So it passed in the Negative.

The main question was then put, and agreed to:

Accordingly the House resolved itself into the said Committee.
