Warrants on the Treatury for maintainance of Poor Persons except such as he is authorized to draw by Virtue of an Act passed this Session for maintainance of the Poor.

Governor authorized to draw Warrants for Solaries to Officers of Government up to the next meeting of General Assumbly at same site as they have been provided for them by this Act for the Year 1791.

Time being, to draw any Warrant or Warrants on the Treasury for the Support or Maintenance of Persons of that Description, save only such Warrants as he is authorized to draw by Virtue of an Act passed this Session, intitled, an Act to provide for the suture Maintenance of the Poor now maintained at the Province Expence.

IX. And be it further Enacted, by the Authority aforesaid, That the several Officers of the Government who have Salaries provided for them by this Act, for the Year of our Lord One Thousand Seven Hundred and Ninety One, shall be paid at the same rate for such Part of the ensuing Year as shall have expired before the next meeting of the General Assembly, and it shall and may be lawful for the Governor, Lieutenant Governor or Commander in Chief for the Time being, to draw Warrants on the Treasury for that Purpose.
