PEOPLE PAY FOR FARCE.

It is now recognized that what ever value the report of the Royal Insurance Commission may have as political literature, it is of no great service in the matter of insurance. The one thing that the organization as a whole seems to have taken seriously was the political inquiry. All the rest is a tumultuous jumble, and the report itself now appears to be an object of ridicule to every person who has knowledge of insurance. The Government has taken no action on the report, and has paid no attention to the draft bill submitted by the Commissioners.
