THAT AMHERST MEETING.

The speeches at the mass meeting of Liberals at Amherst, on Friday, were marked by two very glaring peculiarities. First: the policy of the Conservative administration was condemned from page to premier, but nothing was said concerning the policy of the Liberals, if they were to get to power. Mr. Hawke promised to touch upon what remedies the Liberals proposed, but it is his own report of his speech which occupies a column and a half of the *Transcript* is to be relied upon, no evaded that point. The other peculiarity was that although everyone waited until the McGreavy scandal, not a syllable was uttered about the revelations at Quebec, which point rather alarmingly to the fact that Mr. Pacaud hoodlums the province and some of the money went to help Messrs Hawke, Black's and Emerson's Quebec compatriots in opposing the corrupt Tories.

The neglect on the part of so many Liberal speakers to give their hearers an outline of what their platform and policy really is, is one of the marked features of a Canadian political campaign. That party took Reciprocity with the United States as their platform. March and would hard to bring their standard bearer to the front. They failed. Conservative commissioners went to Washington a few weeks later in the endeavor to bring about the very state of affairs which the Liberals wanted, and the result was a Crit report from Cape Breton to the Pacific but which landed abuse and scurrilous upon our ministers, and threw every possible obstruction in the way of their accomplishing the purpose for which they started. The only rational conclusion regarding the policy of Reciprocity is that it was intended to be a precursor of seats on the Treasury benches and that done the object was to stay there. The record of the Liberal party during the years it was in power may prove interesting to those whose ideal of perfect administration is the present position. Why Mr. Hawke did not point to this record with pride when he condemned the debt incurring proclivities of the Macdonald administration will at once appear. For this great increase we have no considerable public works, while for the last decade of late years we have works of immense public service which both party acknowledge to be invaluable to the country.
