MUNICIPAL COUNCIL.

The Water Agency Committee's Report is Not Adopted.

A special meeting of the council was held Monday evening, Present: Mayor Grant, and Councillors Braden, Pease, Harris, Vigliani, Styles, Wilson, Kelly, Coughlan and Pease.

The object of the meeting was to consider the water committee's report on Mr. Summerfield's letter regarding the new water scheme.

The clerk read the report.

Coun. Pease moved the adoption of the report and said that in the best interests of the city it would be better to come to some mode of procedure with regard to the Summerfield scheme, to be met an Anglo-Saxon, believing as he did in *Magnus Charta*, the majority must rule; not the minority, but he was not prepared to take any such step, he would rather see the public in the first place and he thought it the duty of the council to place this new scheme also before the public. He had prepared a by-law and if his wish would allow him, he would place it on the table.
