ROME, March 2.-The Chamber of Deputies to-day referred to a Parliamentary commission a demand for the prosecution of Deputy Caselli, who is accused of complicity with the Sicilian Socialists in plotting to start a revolution in Italy. The prosecution will take place in Naples, where 40 Socialists and Anarchists implicated in the same plot will be tried.

A MANITOBA MYSTERY.
