

OYSTER SAUCE FOR CODFISH .-One quart of oysters (when buying them ask for a little extra liquor), put over the fire, rub up pieces of butter tize of small egg with two even table-spoonfuls flour; stir this in the oysters till dissolved; pepper and salt to taste, and on no account let it boil more than an instant; the oysters must not be hard. This quantity is sufficient for eight pounds of fish.

PEACH FRITTERS.—Half can of peaches, each cut in half. One cup of flour, one table spoonful butter, one egg. Make a batter of the last three ingredients, using the liquor from the peaches to bring it to the required consistency. About a cupful will be required. Dip the halved peaches into the batter, and drop them one at a time into deep boiling lard. Serve with powdered sugar. These are nice made of fresh peaches. of fresh peaches.

CUSTARD CAKE FILLING. - Boil one cup of sweet milk to which has been added four tablespoonsful of sugar, two of butter and three of flour. Stir the flour to a smooth paste with a little of the milk, before adding it to the other ingredients. When well boiled, add the beaten whites of two eggs, and lemon extract to taste. It is also nice made with the yelks instead of the whites of the eggs.

VEAL AND MACARONI PATE. Chop two cupfuls of cold, boiled macaroni fine. Mix with it a beaten egg, and line a buttered mould-a plain one -with the macaroni. Inside this, place the remains of cold yeal, chopped small. well seasoned, and moistened with gravy. Spread the macaroni over the top of the meat, cover the mould tightly, plunge it into a pot of hoiling water and boil an hour and a half. Turn out in a platter, and pour gravy or drawn butter over it.

LYONNAISE POTATOES. - One quart of cold, boiled potatoes, cut into dice; three table-spoonfuls of butter, one of chopped onion, one of chopped parsley, salt, pepper. Season the potatoes with the salt and pepper. Fry the onions in the butter, and when they turn yellow add the potatoes. Stir with a fork, being careful not to break them. When hot, add the parsley, and cook two minutes longer. Serve immediately on a hot dish.

CAKE FILLING .- Boil one cup of granulated sugar and half a cup of water until it "hairs" when dropped from a spoon. Do not stir it while boiling. Pour it, while hot, on the well beaten white of an egg, beating all together as you pour it on. Let it cool, then add the flavouring. Spread it, thickly, between the layers; and when putting them together do not press them down. them together do not press them down. It is made extra nice by the addition of hickory-nut meats.


