soda, the borax being used on account of its antiseptic properties and the carbonate of soda to help dissolve the resin. A porous tray, the bottom of which consists of two sheets of canvas with a sheet of felt between, is placed over the log, and a sheet of lead connected with the negative pole of the dynamo is placed above this. When the current is turned on, the solution is drawn from the bottom and the sap is driven out, and its place taken by the borax and resin; the time required for a 10 inch log is about seven or eight hours, and then the wood is slowly dried, which takes in the open air in summer several weeks or even months."
