At a meeting held lataly-one of the most influential pablio meetings I think I ever attended, and held in a central room of basiness city life a society was formed, mainly by leading business men of the city, for the parpose of regalating license and other matters of public interest. Now, Cbristian men of this congregation. I ask you to throw in your infaence and money with this society. Suoh an opportunity of united a aotion has never in my memnry 'been given to toe pablic, and it demends the conntenance and monetary support of all interested in the moral weli being of the city.
This is not a question of teetotalsm or moderation ; it is a question as to whether we are going to allow one olass of the community. and that the least useful, if not the most dangerons, to exercias an infuence in the city that is whnlly bad all along the line of its operations. Hence I do hnpe that every leading business man, every ent: plover, every father listening to me will take his stand on the aide o this newly formed Society. and his vame to ithe roll of members and give with liberslity to its fands and thus aid in reatraining the domination of a claps at whose doors may fairly be held a broad indictment for at least one half of the orime and immorslity of this growing city.
Again I would aak the ratepayers in each electoral diatriot to walse up to the fact that under the now law they oan practioally regolate the nomber of licenses in a diatrict, or asy whether they will have any lisenses issued in their distriot at all!

I feel sure that if we organized distrist committees working in unisnn with and as recognized agenta of the newly formed Citizen'sleagne. the whole matter werald lie in our own bands. Wlist we need is the combination and consolidation of tije ratepayers on the side of law and order, the sinking of all differences of religion and nationality, and the constroction of a solid eleotoral vote that legal! y and triomphantly would vindicate the bettor fcelings of this city, and remove the blot that at this moment, under law, rests on its morality. So I leave you with the words of $m y$ text as a guide in this and many other public matters. Render to God the things that are God's. Be loy al to him and the principles of His government and loyalty to Cwsar will be a matter of nataral and consistent growth. And the truest loyalty to Ceesar at times, may be, hin regeneration; it is aqroly BO in
the matter I have noticed; but then such d egoneration. must be legsit. Through law, better laws must be born; and through law. the great change mapt. come, and hence the wisdom of the words that will ever be wise-Render to Cwsar the things that are Cwasr's and to God the thinge that are Grod's.
