SRI LANKA

Sri Lanka does not import a significant quantity of fresh or frozen seafood, as it's domestic fishing fleet and licensed offshore fishing boats satisfy the domestic demand with not much left over for canning. Therefore Sri Lanka does import a considerable amount of canned and dried seafood products. The most popular canned imported products are mackerel and sardines and the exporters are most commonly Thailand and Singapore, though some Canadian products have been spotted on the shelves. The most common export source for dried fish is the Maldives.
