PART IV: FINAL PROVISIONS

ARTICLE 22

Other Assistance

This Treaty shall not derogate from obligations subsisting between the Contracting Parties under other treaties, conventions or agreements, or in any way prevent the Contracting Parties from providing or continuing to provide assistance to each other pursuant to other treaties, conventions, agreements or practices.

ARTICLE 23

Consultation

The Contracting Parties shall consult one another promptly, at the request of either Party, concerning the interpretation and the application of this Treaty.

ARTICLE 24

Entry into Force and Termination

- This Treaty shall enter into force on the date on which the Contracting Parties
 have notified each other that they have fulfilled their legal requirements.
- This Treaty shall apply to any request made after its entry into force even if the relevant conduct occurred prior to this date.
- Either Contracting Party may terminate this Treaty by giving notice to the other Party, and this termination shall take effect one year from the date on which such notice is given.

IN WITNESS WHEREOF the undersigned, being duly authorized by their respective governments, have signed this Treaty.
