

Mr. MacNaught, seconded by Mr. Benidickson, moved in amendment thereto,—That the said bill be not now read a second time but that the subject-matter thereof be referred to the Standing Committee on Privileges and Elections.

And the question being put on the said amendment, it was agreed to.

Accordingly, the said bill was not read the second time but the subject-matter thereof was referred to the Standing Committee on Privileges and Elections.

The hour for Private Members' Business expired.

Bill C-102, An Act to Provide for the Placing of the Maritime Transportation Unions of Canada Under the Management and Control of Trustees, was again considered in Committee of the Whole, reported with amendments, and considered as amended.

By unanimous consent, the said bill was read the third time, on division, and passed.
