STATEMENT BY MR. SPEAKER

MR. SPEAKER: In accordance with my decision of Wednesday, April 23, 1975, I wish to lay on the Table of the House a reprinted version of Bill C-44, An Act to amend the Senate and House of Commons Act, the Salaries Act and the Parliamentary Secretaries Act.

May I remind honourable Members that yesterday the Honourable the President of the Privy Council stated that he hoped that Bill C-44 would be called on Tuesday next. That being the case the period for the filing of motions to amend the Bill at the report stage will not expire before Monday next at 6.00 o'clock p.m.

Bill C-32, An Act to impose a charge on the export of crude oil and certain petroleum products, to provide compensation for certain petroleum costs and to regulate

the price of Canadian crude oil and natural gas in interprovincial and export trade, was again considered in Committee of the Whole and progress having been made and reported, the Committee obtained leave to consider it again later this day.
