

other respects the Visitations of 1845 and 1846 were of equal interest and importance. The importance, indeed, of those Visitations was abundantly proved and manifested by the results which I saw with joy in my last voyage. I cannot be sufficiently thankful that I was enabled to occupy the ground at Burin, Harbour Briton, and La Poêle, at a most critical juncture. How much do I and the Church owe to the sacred ship!
