BY-LAW No. 879.

By-Law Giving Powers to the River Beau-
dette Drainage Committee.

Whereas a By-Law has been recommended
to be passed at the sittings of this Council for
the purpose of deepening River Beaudette
and for draining the land in the vicinity of
the river.

It is therefore enacted,
(1) That the Committee appointed by this
Council to supervise the work be and they are
hereby authorized to let the work by public
tender or otherwise, taking such security from
the contractor or contractors as to them may
seem ample; provide for the supervision of
the work, and take such further actions as
may be necessary for the proper execution in
carrying out the said drainage work.

(2) It is further enacted that the Warden be

BY-LAW No. 882.

By-Law for the Support of Public Schools.

Whereas the United Counties of Stormont,
Dundas and Glengarry are authorized to levy
and collect a sum of money for the support of
Public Schools, and

Whereas it is necessary to levy and collect
a sum of money on the United Counties of
Stormont, Dundas and Glengarry for the sup-
port of Public Schools therein, for the year
1889, and to direct what portions of the said
sum shall be levied for each Township in the
said United Counties.

Be it therefore enacted a By-Law of the said
United Counties that the sum of six thousand
four hundred and forty-nine dollars be levied
and collected from the rateable real and
personal property of the said townships with-
in the said United Counties for the current
