

left winners in said matches. These two clubs shall be entitled to play for the final Intermediate and Junior Championships, respectively, on grounds suitable and convenient to the two clubs competing. Provided always should no agreement as to grounds be arrived at there shall be a series of home matches on dates arranged by the President of the Association, and the winner of the greater number of goals in the two matches shall be declared the winner of the finals, and shall be entitled to the Intermediate and Junior Championships, respectively. That the receipts in the semi-final matches shall be kept by the home team, and in case the finals be home and home matches, the receipts be kept by the home team; and in case the finals be played off at one place, the receipts shall be divided equally after the Railway and Hotel expenses of each team (14 men), and the necessary expenses of the match, are defrayed; or in case the receipts are not sufficient for such expenses, the amount shall be divided between the clubs in proportion to the actual expenses incurred.

RULE XIII.

BANNERS.

Sec. 1. The clubs holding the Senior and Intermediate Championship Banners shall each file with the President of the Association a Bond in the Penal Sum of One Hundred Dollars, with one or more good and sufficient sureties, payable to the President, for the safe keeping of the said Banners, and the clubs holding any of the District Banners shall file a similar Bond in the Penal sum of Twenty-Five Dollars.

Sec. 2. All of the said Banners shall be delivered to the Secretary of the Association on or before the 1st day of November in each year. The Secretary shall examine the same and if they have not been injured in the hands of the holders, he shall at once notify the President of the Association, who will deliver up and cancel the Bond for the same. As soon as the President notifies the Secretary that a good and sufficient Bond has been filed, he shall at once deliver the said Banners to the Clubs entitled to hold the same.
