The name of Robt. W. Chambers has been a well-known one in the literary world, both before and after his death. "The Younger Set," now appearing in book form, is a different sort of story, but one equally enthralling from cover to cover of the book.

The man whom she comes nearest to loving leaves her for a mere cad—she is a woman without a code, without a class, without any anchor in life. The one possible refuge for her, the doing of her duty, is rendered foreign to her character. When the race produces many such women as Allice, the sacredness of home will become a myth and a legend. She is the very embodiment of that spirit of aggressive restlessness which keeps the divorce courts busy.

The problem which has raised (what is to become of society?) by the usual means—she introduced a blameless woman to rebuild what others have torn down. Poor souls! We have been doing it ever since the world began; it seems to be part of the curse of Eve. For the sake of the vanity and vices of the few, little children die daily, body and soul, in the slums, and "society" as represented by the press, the pulpit and the law, cries out to women, "Why this race-suicide? Be fruitful, be mothers, and bring into the world more children; for them is the strength of the race founded." The trouble is that the penalties of failure under our present system are too great. The home is no longer protected from the disintegrating forces of great wealth or one hand and abject poverty on the other. Children are no blessing, but a rising young man, Phillips Oppenheim, treats the social problem in the United States in a breezy fashion of his own in "The Social Problem."
