London, Dec. 7 (Correspondence of the Associated Press).—Secrets of the war which the British Secret Service now revealed show that German spies or agents of the German government were making active preparations, even before the beginning of hostilities, to use the Isle of Wight as a landing place for German forces and for the bombardment of Portsmouth. One of the first preparations taken in August, 1914, was to place a certain cottage and, although no lights were shown, the patent observers finally solved the mystery. They learned that

#### WELCOME TO JEWS IN CONVENTION IN TORONTO

Toronto, Ont., Jan. 7.—Formal welcome to Jews in attendance at a Zionist convention here was extended yesterday by Hon. N. W. Rowell, privy councillor, on behalf of the dominion government.




