The Rev. Canon Norman proposed that the Bishop name a committee to suggest names for trustees and members of Council for Bishops College, Lennoxville.

The BISHOP named the following committee:

Rev. Canon Norman, Rev. R. Lindsay, Rev. F. Robinson, Dr. Sullivan; Messrs. W. B. Simpson, L. H. Davidson, N. S. Whitney, Canon Norman (Convener).

Notices of motion were handed in by Mr. Leo. H. Davidson and T. White.

Mr. Baydges moved the adoption of the Executive Committee's report, (see page 156,) seconded by Mr. Hutton.

A discussion ensued, and it was decided that the revised list of grants contained in the report shall be the basis upon which the Committee shall act; but that grants made to missions may in special cases be reconsidered, when sufficient grounds for reconsideration exist. A special grant to the catechist at North Gore, the grants to Grenville, Upton and Roxton Falls, North Shefford and Warden, were named for consideration by the Executive Committee.

Mr. Brydges' motion was then put, and the report was adopted.

On motion by Rev. Canon BALDWIN, the Rev. Knanishu Moratkan was invited to a seat in the House.

The BISHOP added the name of Rev. Dr. Sullivan to the Committee on Intemperance.

The BISHOP, at the request of the Bishop of Fredericton, named a committee to select a suitable place of meeting forthe Provincial Synod, viz.:—Messrs. Brydges, J. Hutton, Canon Norman, and the secretaries.

The Bishop also named Canon Norman and Dr. Sullivan to select a Committee on Hospitality for Provincial Synod.

Moved by Mr. BRYDGES, seconded by Mr. HUTTON:

That in future the Theological Diocesan College be not charged with a proportion of the different expenses, but that they be charged a rent of \$170 a year to cover all charges and expenses of every kind.—

It was agreed that the Rev. Mr. Moratkhan be permitted to address the Synod at four o'clock to-day.
